From the Manager's Desk...this and that

At this writing we are nearing the one year anniversary of the establishment of our prairie. Last November, Midwest Prairies, of Milton, Wisconsin, seeded about 10 acres of our fields, of which about 4 acres are newly designated for Natural Burial.

Our Chapel had an exterior makeover. New windows replaced those that date back to the 1930's...weather resistant trim and fresh paint were the finishing touches.

Again this year we were proud to partner with the Geese Police of Whitewater. Susan and Mike, and their border collies chase away Canadian Geese in a non-lethal manner. The result for the geese is that Prairie Home is viewed as place to be flown over, while the rest of us have cleaner grounds.

While many municipalities, including Waukesha are involved in extensive leaf pick-up at this time of the year, PHC will again mulch fallen leaves. Environmentally this enriches our turf, and is much more efficient for us than gathering and hauling leaves for disposal.

New roads were installed for our natural burial (section 12) area. 2011 will see work done on the Committal Area.

Natural Prairie-Year One

Our Prairie did great in its first year, and next year you should see even more prairie flowers and grasses. Slowly, annual weeds will be crowded out. Here is a list of some of the plants we have. Anise, Nodding Pink Onion, Lead Plant, Canada Anemone, Thimbleweed, Swamp Milkweed, Prairie Milkweed, various varieties of Aster, White and Purple Clover, Coneflowers, Sunflowers, St. John's Wort, Bergamot, Blazing Star, Wild Quinine, Foxglove, Brown and Black-eyed Susans, Goldenrod, German-der, Sedges, Ryes, Switch Grass, Big and Little Bluestems, and others.

Plans next spring are to have informational handouts of the complete list of plants in outdoor racks. Watch the prairie change with the seasons.
