



Honor a Veteran Today by Endowing a Memorial Flag at Prairie Home Cemetery

What is Included in the Program

A 3' x 5' American flag on a 10' flagpole personalized with the name and service record of the veteran. The flags are flown on Prairie Home's main drive on Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, and Veterans Day each year. You will also receive an Endowment Certificate which indicates that your flag will be provided every year, in perpetuity.

Who Can Participate

All veterans, living or deceased, are eligible to participate. The veteran does not have to be interred at Prairie Home or own property in the cemetery. If the veteran is living and intends to be buried at Prairie Home, his or her sole flag will fly on the day of interment.

How To Endow a Flag— prices subject to change.

Simply complete an application and return it to the cemetery office along with the endowment fee of \$680.00, plus 5.1% sales tax =(\$714.68), or your first installment of six at \$119.12. (Your participation in the program will begin when paid in full. This fee covers the cost of the initial flag, bronze plaque, and installation, labor to place and remove the flag for each event and also provides for replacement of these materials as they become worn or damaged.
